

# Privacy Policy Statement

Our primary aim is to provide quality health care to the patient. To do so requires the collection by the Practice of patient health information from time to time. The Practice will only request information of a nature properly required for your treatment.

The Practice conforms to privacy legislation and the National Privacy Principles set out in the Privacy Act. All health information provided by you, the patient, to the Practice will remain confidential and will not be disclosed to any third party, including other treating health professionals, without the patient's prior consent.

All health information is retained in secure storage and all staff members are familiar with the obligation to treat your records confidentially.

You are entitled to review your health information held by the Practice. If you wish to access your information you should discuss this with your treating provider. Similarly, if you have any concerns about the Practice's treatment of your health information, you should discuss these concerns with your treating provider.
