ASSOCIATIONS INCORPORATION ACT, 1984

(CLAUSE 10)

RULES

PART 1

PRELIMINARY

Interpretation

1. (1) In these rules, except in so far as the context or subject-matter otherwise indicates or requires:

"accredited member" means a person who has obtained a certificate of membership from the Examination Board of the Association and who otherwise complies with the Rules of the Association.

"accredited member level 2" means an accredited member of the Association, who the Examination Board of the Association considers to be an advanced practitioner and has undertaken extensive training, education and/or examination.

"accredited teacher/examiner" means an accredited member of the Association who the Committee of the Association considers is sufficiently qualified through training, education or examination to be a teacher of modalities as recognised by A.R.M. or to be a member of the Examination Board.

"affiliate member" means a person or organisation recognised by the Committee of the Association as being a person or an organisation who has an interest in the Association's objects and who wishes to receive the Association's newsletter.

"Certificate of Membership" means a certificate awarded to applicants for membership of the Association who satisfy the requirements for membership of the Association fixed by the Committee of the Association from time to time.

"Committee member" means a member of the Committee who is not an office-bearer of the Association, as referred to in Rule 12(2);

"Examination Board" means the sub-committee of the Association to whom the power to assess by practical and written examination persons applying for membership who have not been trained by an ARM Accredited Teacher. To assess accredited members for accredited member level 2 and new teacher applicants for accreditation as accredited teachers of the Association.

"member" means a person who has attained a Certificate of Membership from the Examination Board of the Association and who otherwise complies with the Rules of the Association and includes accredited member, accredited member level 2, and an accredited teacher/examiner.

"retired member" means a former member who because of age, ill health or otherwise has ceased to be a member but who the Committee of the Association considers because of service to the profession or the Association should remain a member of the Association.

"trainee member" means a person in training for a Certificate of Membership to become a member of the Association.

"secretary" means:

- (a) the person holding office under these rules as secretary of the Association; or
- (b) where no such person holds that office - the public officer of the Association;

"special general meeting" means a general meeting of the Association other than annual general meeting;

"the Act" means the Associations Incorporation Act, 1984;

"the Regulation" means the Associations Incorporation Regulation, 1985. (2) In these rules:

- (a) a reference to a function includes a reference to a power, authority and duty; and
- (b) a reference to the exercise of a function includes, where the function is a duty, a reference to the performance of the duty.

The provisions of the Interpretation Act, 1987, apply to and in respect of these rules in the same manner as those provisions would so apply if these rules were an instrument made under the Act. (3)
